



Organic Management Plans

The plans incorporate an approach that encompasses a systematic view of all farming practices that relies on an understanding of the ecological processes on a property and using these processes to manage the problems that occur.

The plan is designed to build a robust system on the property that is able to resist the pressure of disease and pest attack while maintaining or improving quality.

Plans include chapters on:

- Crop Nutrition: The basic objective is to build soil biological health, humus levels and to balance the nutrients in the soil to provide a good nutrient base for the crop.
 - Details on soil amendments required to maximise crop growth are listed
 - Details on foliar sprays and fertigation to supplement nutrients obtained from the soil are listed
 - A plan to monitor soil and plant health indicators is provided
- Cover Crops: Build humus levels, increase soil nitrogen levels, improve soil friability and cation exchange capacity and suppress winter weeds.
 - Details of the best cover crops for your situation are provided along with information about how to plant them.
- Pest and Disease Control: Depending on the crop, farmers need to be observant of the particular pests and diseases likely to affect them.
 - Information of the pests and diseases likely to affect your crop and how to manage them are provided
- Weed Management: The aim is to reduce the competition from weeds during the growing season.
 - Options for weed management are suggested
- Spray Program:
 - A table outlining the spray program is provided
- Product Information: Details of the various products mentioned in the plan are provided
